

Wonewoc Police Department is hosting a “Drug Drop Off Box”

Location: Wonewoc Village Hall

When: Weekday business hours 7:30am to 3:30pm

Community is welcome to bring in unused or expired medications for proper disposal in a safe, convenient, and responsible means while also educating the general public about the potential for abuse of these medications.

Medications should never be flushed or poured down the drain. Water reclamation facilities are not designed to remove products in these pharmaceuticals as contaminants are showing up in rivers and lakes nationwide.

What can be Collected: Prescription (controlled and non-controlled) and over the counter medications, ointments, patches, non-aerosol sprays, inhalers, creams, vials, and pet medications.

Not Permitted: Illegal drugs, needles/sharps, liquids, aerosol cans, bio-hazard materials (blood or bodily fluid), hazardous waste, and personal care products.

*Dispose of solid medications by removing the medication from its container and placing them in a clear sealable plastic bag. Plastic pill containers should not be collected. Bubble packages are acceptable without the medications being removed. Please remove all labeling before disposal.
